After completing the SPEAK UP Champion and Ambassador Conferences, participants can apply to become SPEAK UP Faculty which allows them to teach the education with the support of PQI.

TO APPLY TO BECOME SPEAK UP FACULTY, APPLICANTS MUST:

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- □ Be a current PQI Professional paid member.
- □ Be a current perinatal health clinician and have five years of clinical experience or a public health professional with at least three years of experience.
- □ Be a RN with a master's degree (DNP or doctorate preferred, certification desirable), physician (with valid US medical license), social worker, public health professional or midwife (with valid US license).
- Participated in perinatal professional development activities (CNE/CME) within the past three years.
- Must attend the virtual 4 hour SPEAK UP Faculty Course on Tuesday, August 22, 2023 at 8:30AM 12:30PM.

Applicants must have successfully completed the following education in its entirety within the past three years:

- SPEAK UP Champion Implicit and Explicit Racial Bias Education (8 hours)
- SPEAK UP Ambassador İmplicit and Explicit Racial Bias Education (6 hours)
- Viewed PQI's Birth Equity Webinars
- SPEAK UP E-Learning Modules Implicit and Explicit Racial Bias Education
- Harvard Implicit Bias (Race IAT) Self-Assessment
